Typical working pattern in this placement	9 am ward rounds every day, and ward jobs. Attending lunch-time teaching sessions. Session of 1st on call covering A+E (2pm-9.30pm) 2x session of 2nd on call covering the ward (5pm- 9,30pm) Nights 12 nights during a 4 months rotation.
Employer information	George Eliot Hospital has been an NHS Trust Hospital since 1994. The majority of the Hospital is based in modern purpose built accommodation.  There are approximately 286 beds, including eight critical care beds, 12 day case beds and a coronary care unit with 11 beds. There are 14 inpatient wards. The trust has eight operating theatres providing planned and emergency surgical facilities for trauma and orthopaedics, general surgery, urology and gynaecology. They also offer a wide range of day case procedures, for adults and children aged 2 to 16 years old There is an Education Centre (GETEC) with excellent library facilities, Simulation Suite, a Clinical Skills Centre and numerous teaching rooms including a Lecture Theatre.  There is a very strong commitment to junior staff training
