

PRIVACY NOTICE – Wi-Fi Analytics

<p>George Eliot Hospital provides Wi-Fi to patients, staff, volunteers and visitors to the Trust. Wi-Fi analytics allow the Trust to analyse the movement of devices within the Trust and help to provide efficiencies and cost savings.</p>	
1) Data Controller	<p>George Eliot Hospital NHS Trust College Street Nuneaton CV10 7DJ</p>

3) Purpose of the processing	<p>Analyse Wi-Fi data to produce anonymous reports to better understand flow through the hospital and the usage of Trust devices.</p> <p>Locate and track and recover lost or stolen Trust devices.</p>
4) Lawful basis for processing	<p>The General Data Protection Regulations and the Data Protection Act 2018 allow us to process your data under the following conditions:</p> <p>Where we process your personal or special category data we will do so in order to comply with a legal obligation to which the Trust is subject.</p> <p>Article 6: 6(1)(f) processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller or by a third party except where such interests are overridden by the interests or fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject which require protection of personal data, in particular where the data subject is a child</p> <p>Article 9: N/A</p> <p>Other information: (c) Legal obligation: Data may be additionally processed for the prevention and detection of crime or another legal obligation.</p>
5) Recipient or categories of recipients of the shared data	<p>Personal data will not be shared with any third parties unless a legal obligation requires it.</p>
6) Rights to object	<p>You have the right to object to GEH processing your personal data. Data subjects can opt-out of the collection of personal data by turning their mobile devices off or turning them on to airplane mode when within the Trust site.</p>
7) Right to access and rectification	<p>The Data Subjects or legal representatives have the right to access the data that is being shared and have any inaccuracies corrected. There is no right to have accurate medical records deleted except when ordered by a court of Law.</p>

8) Retention period	Pseudonymised data is kept for 30 days
