<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	9am ward/board rounds every day. ward jobs attending MDT reviewing pts on other wards 1x session of 1st on call covering A+E (2pm-930pm) 2x session of 2nd on call covering the ward (5pm- 930pm) Nights 12 nights during a 4 months rotation. All on calls full shift EWTD compliant rota
