Individual Placement Description – George Eliot Hospital

<b>Placement</b>	FY2 General Surgery
<b>The department</b>	General Surgery, Breast surgery and endocrine surgery
<b>The type of work to expect and learning opportunities</b>	<p>The trainee will gain experience in ward-based pre and postoperative care of surgical patients, minor surgical procedures under local anaesthetic and basic surgical operations such as appendectomy and abscess drainage. The trainee will be exposed to major surgical operations in conjunction with the consultant and SpR.</p> <p>There is a weekly study period, a surgical CME session (Friday pm) and a radiology meeting in the postgraduate centre.</p>
<b>Where the placement is based</b>	George Eliot Hospital
<b>Supervisor(s) for the placement</b>	Mr Kishore Makam
<b>Main duties of the placement</b>	The trainee will participate in ward rounds, outpatient clinics, inpatient surgery and day surgery. A senior doctor will always be available during clinic sessions for advice. During the time working in surgery, the trainee will be expected to undertake an audit or similar project.
<b>Typical working pattern in this placement</b>	The trainee will participate in the full shift system on call rota.
<b>Employer information</b>	George Eliot Hospital has been an NHS Trust Hospital since 1994. The majority of the Hospital is based in modern purpose built accommodation. Currently there are 350 beds divided between the major specialities. There is a new Postgraduate Medical Centre with excellent library facilities, a clinical skills training unit and a computer skills training centre. There is a very strong commitment to junior staff training
