Placement	FY2 Obstetrics & Gynaecology
The department	Obstetrics & Gynaecology
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	Care of elective and emergency patients with gynaecological problems and some experience on labour ward. Job will also include experience in gynaecological and antenatal clinics, specialist clinics, management of ward patients, gynaecological emergencies, labour ward patients and theatre sessions. There are weekly lectures (Monday AM) as well as morbidity and mortality meeting. Tuesday lunch-time on alternate weeks.

Supervisor(s) for the placement	Mr Gary Lawrence
Main duties of the placement	As above. FY2 works on the junior tier of the rota and is supported at all times by a middle grade and the on call consultant.
Typical working pattern in this placement	The F2 may be on cover for O&G emergencies at any one time (week-day daytime only). These emergency sessions have 1 consultant, 1-2 registrars and 1-2 junior trainees on-call for both obstetrics and gynaecology, and so are fully supervised. Daytime working only (no on call) start time 08:30
Employer information	George Eliot Hospital has been an NHS Trust Hospital since 1994. The majority of the Hospital is based in modern purpose built accommodation. Currently there are 350 beds divided between the major specialities. The Postgraduate Medical Centre has excellent library facilities, a clinical skills training unit and a computer skills training centre. There is a very strong commitment to junior staff training
